
How can we better protect natural and cultural resources while increasing access and benefits for current and future residents?

What Do You Value Most About Henry County?

(Public Survey Question 1 - Top 4 Responses)



The vast majority of Henry County is rural with large areas of the County considered to be of high environmental and natural value. These assets are recognized and appreciated by residents and the many parks and outdoor recreation opportunities highlight the values of the community. Integration of ecotourism planning into Henry's planning efforts supports these values. Continued protection of these assets is necessary to ensure their long-term resilience and the overall health and wellness of the community.



Henry County has a unique history and story that is worthy of state and national recognition. The County's built and natural environment tell this unique story. Capturing the region's history, promoting it to attract tourism, and reinvesting in historic areas to meet modern needs are some of the most effective strategies the community can pursue to create a vibrant future for the County. The community overwhelmingly supports the revitalization of the County's mill towns and successes, such as the School Drive Apartments adaptive reuse and Fieldale Community Center project, provide a solid foundation to continue revitalization efforts. Reinvesting in mill towns allows the community to leverage these assets to tell the story of a resilient and determined community, to create places with quality of life that are attractive to people of all ages, and to protect undeveloped areas of the County from sprawl.

It must also balance growth with environmental protection. By prioritizing access to natural areas, implementing the strategies from the Active Transportation Plan, and promoting ecotourism, the County can encourage healthier lifestyles, support local businesses, and preserve its scenic beauty for future generations.
